ORDINANCE NO. 22-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CEDAR VALLEY WHEREBY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE POSITIONS OF CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER WHICH PASSED BY A MAJORITY VOTE AND PROVIDED THE FORM OF THE BALLOT TO BE UTILIZED AT THE ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Cedar Valley, during their regularly scheduled meeting on July 11, 2022, by Ordinance provided for the submission to a vote of the registered voters of the City the question of providing for the appointment by the Board of Trustees of the positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance passed by a majority vote of the City Board of Trustees and said Trustees set a date specific for election on the 1st day of August, 2022 to determine the desire of the registered voters of the City of Cedar Valley; and

WHEREAS, 11 O.S. Section 16-207 requires that a ballot be submitted to the registered voters in the format suggested by state statute; and

WHEREAS, the ballot question providing for the appointment of the positions City Clerk and City Treasurer read substantially as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, it was resolved that the Board of Trustees of the City of Cedar Valley, agreed to submit the questions regarding the appointment of a Clerk and Treasurer to a vote of the registered voters with a specific date of said election within the body of this Ordinance and the vote to appoint the positions was approved.

<u>Emergency:</u> It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Cedar Valley, Oklahoma and the habitants thereof, an emergency is thereby determined to exist. By reason whereof it is necessary that this ordinance shall go into full effect and be of force immediately upon passage and publication.
